我們除了繼續利用資訊及通訊科技來服務社群,以及為我們的會員在本地、中國大陸及新市場探索和建立不同的機會, 今年亦會呈獻另一重要的跨業界新猷 - 「電子健康聯盟」。我們深信電子健康將是人類未來存續的要素之一,亦將為香港 資訊及通訊科技業界創造新的機遇。我們的合作伙伴的反應熱烈,實在令人鼓舞,我們希望此項目能取得豐碩的成果。

我謹此感謝所有常務理事會成員、執行委員會成員、各委員會成員及本會所有員工過去一年的辛勞及貢獻,以及感謝所 有會員、義工及各方好友對本會的支持。有你們的鼎力支持,展望未來,我深信本會的成績將會更上一層樓。

## 會長葛珮帆博士的話 Message from Dr. Elizabeth Quat President of iProA

The year 2005 was a very busy and fruitful year for iProA. Many of our projects have achieved special breakthrough and accomplishment, especially in cross-industry and cross-border collaborations. It is my great pleasure in reporting to our members and friends some major achievements of the Association in the past year in this Annual Report.

Nearly 300 new members joined iProA in 2005. iProA now represents over 1,160 (at the end of 2005) individual ICT professionals, including 415 voting members.

In 2005, iProA operated under the leadership of 23 Council Members. Its activities were managed by 51 volunteer members of its Executive Committee, which comprised 1.7 Committees and 4 SIGs, together with 4 full time staff.

I had mixed feelings with joys and gratitude which no words can express when I was preparing this Report.

This Report is a fruit of tremendous commitment and effort, many days and nights of hard work, and most of all, unbelievable passion of our volunteer members' contribution to the Hong Kong ICT industry and Hong Kong as a whole. None of the projects shown in this Report were easy to achieve. Behind the scenes were lots of patience, creativity, strategies, persistence, incredible energy and unbreakable teamwork. We have demonstrated our commitment to the society and proven that ICT professionals can contribute to Hong Kong, to mankind, and to our world more than technical know how. I am so proud to having the opportunity to serve the society with such a great team of professionals.

Moving into the seventh year, iProA is turning a new page with a new structure. A new Supervisory Committee has been formed to further enhance our association's governance. An Advisory Board, a collection of eminent experts around the world of ICT and non ICT sectors, will be established for giving us advises, especially in matters related to cross-sector and cross-border collaboration. Furthermore, we are inviting members to join the Management Committee to lay a more solid foundation of hands and brains to support the projects initiated by the Executive Committee.

In addition to our on-going promotion of ICT for community services and our effort to explore and create opportunities for our member here in Hong Kong, in Mainland China, and in emerging markets such as Middle East, we will launch another new important cross-industry initiative in 2006 - the "eHealth Consortium". The objectives of the consortium are to facilitate and promote the use of ICT as a complementary tool in the health care industry, and to enhance the accessibility, quality and effectiveness of health care services in Hong Kong. We believe "eHealth" is essential for human survival and will create new opportunities for the Hong Kong ICT industry. The overwhelming responses from our partners of the project are very encouraging and we are looking forward to the positive results of the project.

Please allow me to express my heartfelt thanks to all Council members, Executive Committee members, members of various Committees and staff of iProA for their hard work and contributions to the Association over the past year; and to various Departments of the HKSAR Government, all our members, volunteers, and friends who have supported iProA. With your unrelenting support, I am confident that we will continue to break new grounds in the years to come.
