Ir Dr Ho Pui Tak is Deputy Director of the Computer Centre, HKU, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Hong Kong Internet Registration Corporation Limited (HKIRC) elected by the IT Industry sector. He received his B.Sc.(Eng), M.Phil. and Ph.D. degrees from HKU in 1977, 1981 and 1988, respectively, and was a DAAD scholar in 1980-82 attached to TU Berlin. He is a Chartered Engineer, Chartered Fellow of the British Computer Society (FBCS CITP), Fellow of the Institute of Electrical Engineers (FIEE) and Fellow of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (FHKIE).

For over 20 years, he has led many strategic IT projects for HKU and the tertiary education sector, e.g. PKI-Electronic Services Delivery applications, University Portal, Campus Network, High-Performance Computing and Bioinformatics systems, the Hong Kong Academic and Research Network (HARNET) and its Next Generation Internet development, etc. Ir Dr Ho has been an enthusiastic promoter of IT Professionalism and the status of IT Professionals in Hong Kong. He is Chairman of the Information Discipline Advisory Panel of HKIE, a Member of HKIE's Qualification and Membership Board, Chairman of the BCS Professional Review Interview Panel in Hong Kong, and Vice-President of the Hong Kong Information Technology Joint Council (HKITJC). He had also served as Chairman of British Computer Society (HK Section) and committee officials of HKIE's IT Division and Control, Automation and Instrumentation (CAI) Division.
