He started his career as an engineer in Dataproducts Ltd. and held executive positions in Sun Hung Kai (China) Limited and Hewlett-Packard (Asia Pacific) Ltd. In 1991, C.S. founded C&T and successfully led the company to be listed on the main board of the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong in 1998.

C&T has successfully introduced many innovative I.T. solutions to the Mainland China and Hong Kong. Over the years, C&T has received numerous recognitions from the Government of the People's Republic of China (PRC) as well as international organizations including:
